REGENERATIVE TOURISM: The term has introduced a new way of thinking about tourism, which in some ways surpasses concepts such as sustainable or responsible tourism: while these two focus on reducing the negative impact of tourism on places, regenerative tourism instead aims to generate value, to contribute to environmental, economic, and social well-being.

RESPONSIBLE TOURISM: Aims to make places better for both tourists and residents, highlights the need to take responsibility for the impact of tourism activity.



SLOW TOURISM: Slow tourism is a way of travel that is experience-centered, slow, in-depth, and allows for deep immersion and knowledge of the destination.

SUSTAINABLE TOURISM: Sustainable tourism aims to minimize the negative effects and maximize the positive effects of tourism on the environment, society and the economy.
